

Texas Requirements

Students must complete a registration form and provide specific health documents before they can start attending our preschool each year. The registration forms ensure we capture information to provide students a safe learning environment as well as comply with all licensing requirements. If offered a seat, please be prepared to provide the following:

Health and Medical Information

- Required
 - Documentation supporting your child has had a [screening or professional examination for possible vision and hearing challenges](#), or a signed affidavit by you that the vision or hearing screening conflicts with tenets or practices of a church or religious denomination of which you are an adherent or member (required if your child is 4 years old by September 1st of the admissions year)
 - For new students, confirmation that a health-care professional has examined your child within the past year and your child is able to participate in the program, or that medical diagnosis and treatment conflict with the tenets and practices of a recognized religious organization that you are an adherent member. For returning students, either a written [health statement](#) from a healthcare professional who has examined your child within the last year, or a signed affidavit from you stating that medical diagnosis and treatment conflict with the tenets and practices of a recognized religious organization of which you are an adherent or a member, or a signed statement from you giving the name and address of a health-care professional who has examined your child within the past year stating that your child is able to participate in the program
 - Either an [official immunization record](#) from a state or local health authority, health care provider or pharmacy, or [notarized affidavit or exemption statement for exemptions](#)

- Required if applicable to your child
 - [Emergency Care Plan](#) (ECP) signed by a health care provider (ECP's are required if your child has an allergy, food intolerance, or other medical condition that could require care while attending Bezos Academy)
 - Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP)
 - [Medication Authorization Form](#) (required if your child has any prescribed medications, including for continuous, long-term use, that will need to be administered during the school day)
 - [AAP Allergy and Anaphylaxis Emergency Plan](#) (required if your child has a life-threatening allergy)

Date of Birth Verification

- Provide one of the following:
 - Birth certificate
 - Health records with date of birth displayed
 - Photo of passport with date of birth displayed

- Photo of identification card with date of birth displayed

Income Verification

For new families

- Provide proof of participation in one of the following programs:
 - Food Assistance Program (FAP)
 - Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program
 - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Program
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefit
- For families that do not participate in a program, provide one of the following as proof of your family gross income for all working members of the family:
 - Pay stubs (two most recent, consecutive)
 - Tax return (most recent)
 - W2-Wages and tax statement (most recent)
 - Employer letter stating the total gross income from the last 12 months
- Income from the last month for all working members of your family
